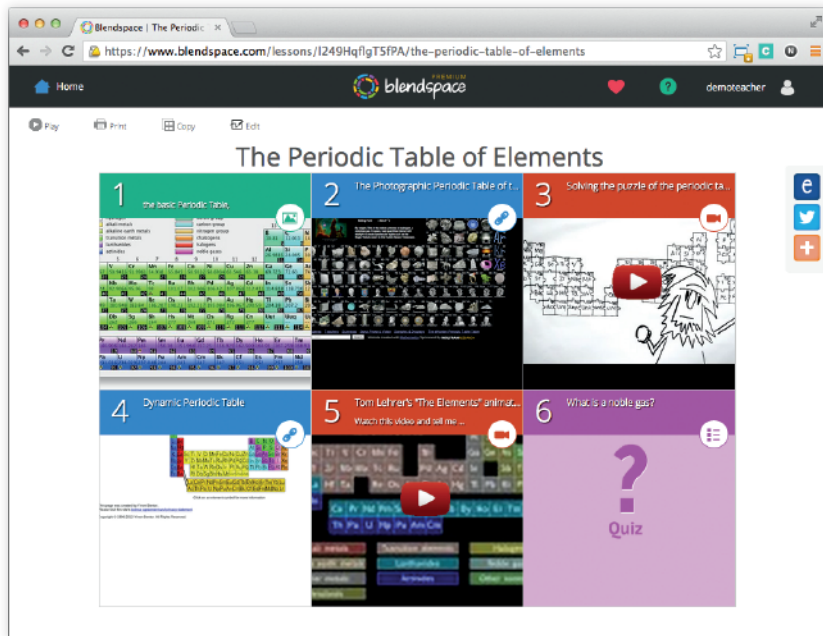

## Student assignments

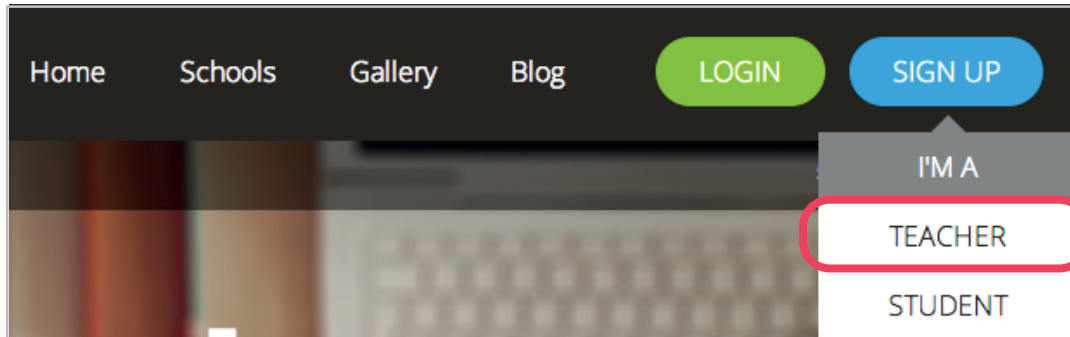
Research assignments. Web quests. Presentations. Students use Blendspace to practice and demonstrate 21st century learner skills.



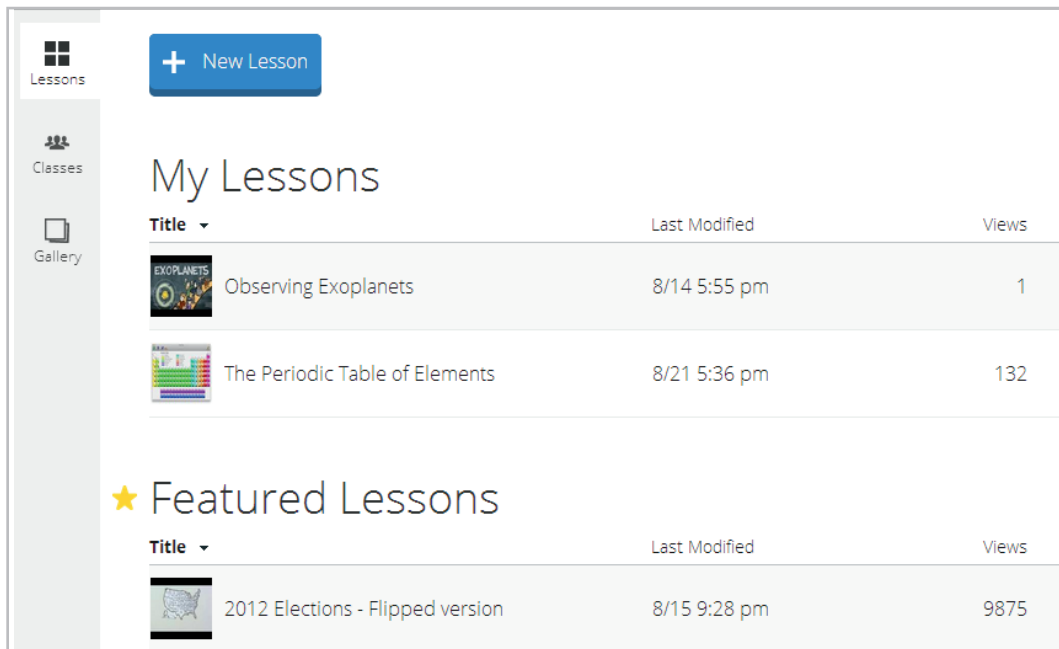

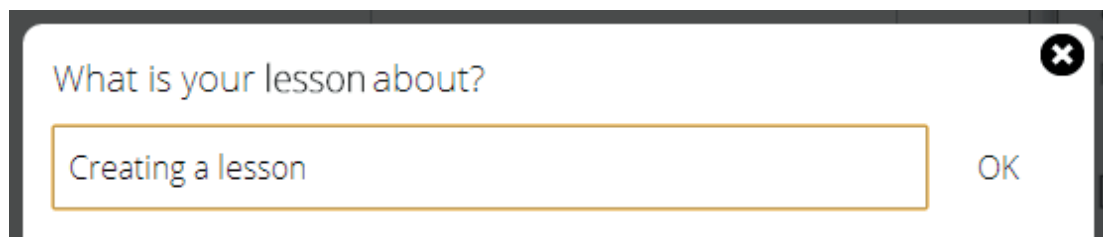

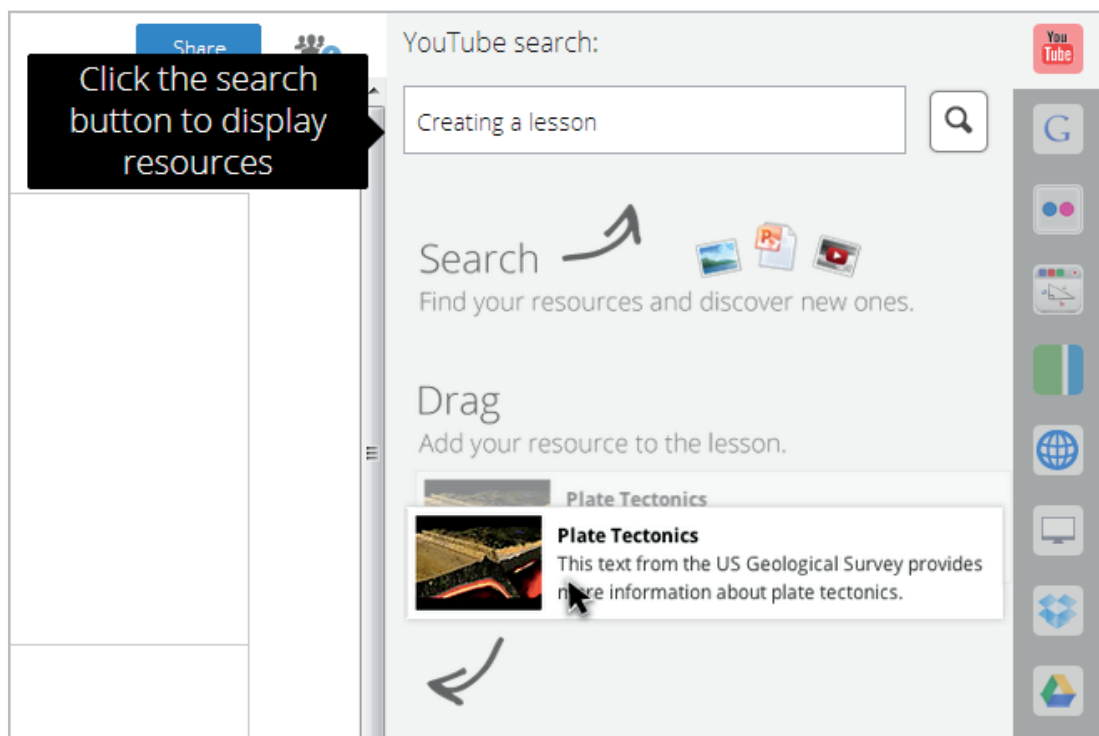

1 Title your lesson



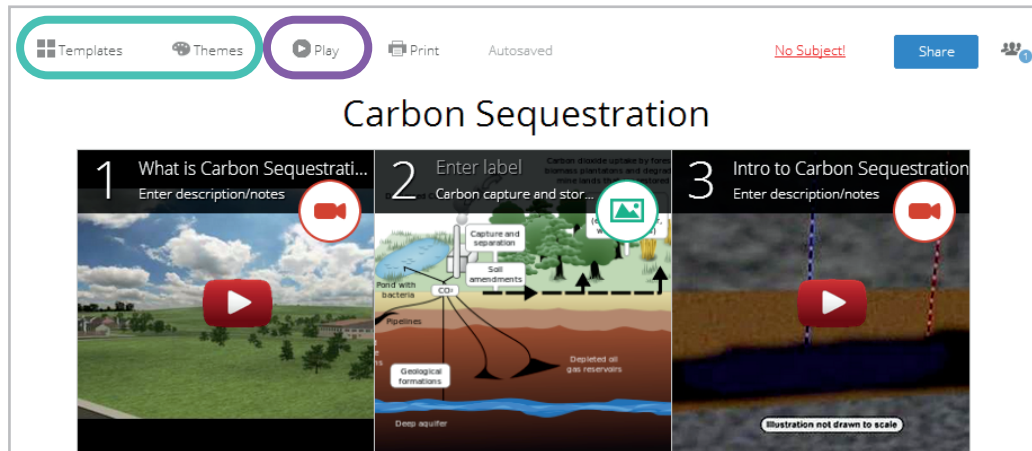
2 Search

3 Pick a source

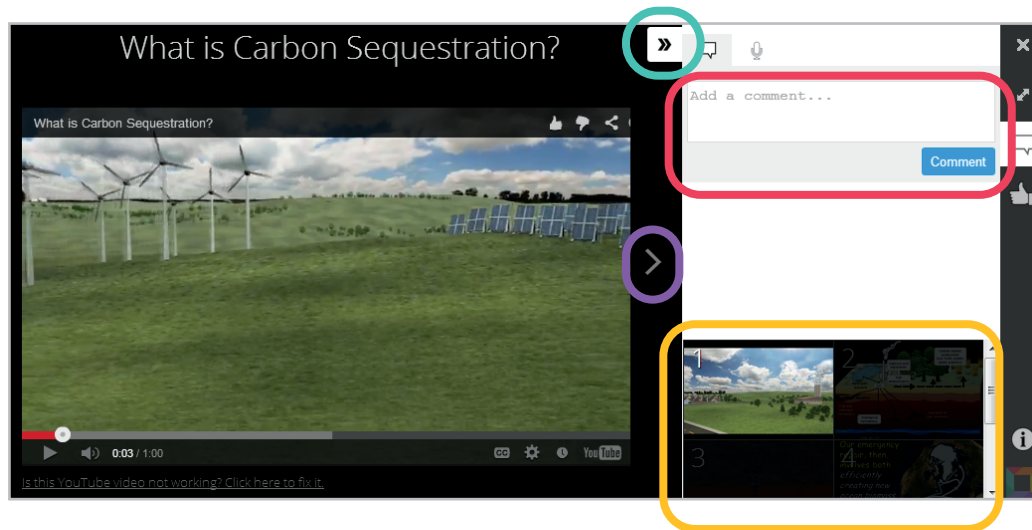
4 Drag and drop content into tile
